A. Copy of the certified translation of Master's or the last obtained diploma (in case the applicant has not finished his/her Master's studies, he/she shall submit a certificate proving the current year of study at home university and the expected date of obtaining his/her Master's diploma, issued by the home university). If applying for Master's scholarship, a transcript of academic records is also required.

B. Letter of acceptance from the host university/institution (should not be older than 3 months when submitting the application). If the applicant applied for courses that require admission tests or personal interview, the results of which will be known only after the deadline for the application, the applicant shall submit a proof of his/her application for studies at the host university/institution. The actual letter of acceptance shall be submitted before the signing of the contract by the IVF, by the end of July of the respective year at the latest.

C. Working plan of the study/research period accepted by the host university/institution (should not be older than 3 months when submitting the application) If the applicant applied for courses that require admission tests or personal interview, the results of which will be known only after the deadline for the scholarship applications, the applicant shall submit a draft of the working plan. The working plan, accepted by the host university/institute, shall be submitted before the signing of the contract by the IVF, by the end of July of the respective year at the latest. If the applicant applies for Master's scholarship, he/she shall submit a list of courses that he/she plans to attend and state the length of these courses and their credits.

All annexes must be in English and should be attached to the application.
